



Hamden Art League Exhibition at the Eli Whitney Barn

May 30 – June 2, 2024
940 Whitney Ave, Hamden, CT

- Eligibility:** Paid-up HAL members, two entries allowed, \$10 each plus PayPal fee. Non-members, one entry allowed, \$15 each plus PayPal fee. Payment is made through the Hamden Art League website (<https://www.hamdenartleague.org/join--pay.html>)
- Medium:** Oils, acrylics, graphics, watercolors, pastels, collage, printmaking (hand printed etching, monotype, lithography, etc), wall-hung relief art (not to exceed 3" protrusion and 20 lbs.), art quilt/fabric art (limited in size to 60" x 60" with hanging pocket), and a limited number of sculptures on pedestal (18" x 18" base dimension limit, 30 lb. weight limit). This is a unique opportunity for large, over-sized artwork.
- Participation:** Entries must be submitted electronically through the Hamden Art League website by midnight **Monday, May 13th**. Submission of an image of artwork is *required*. Show is non-juried for entries but judged for awards by **Greg Shea**. See website for further information (<https://www.hamdenartleague.org/exhibitions.html>).
- Receiving:** **Wednesday, May 29th** between 11 am - 1 pm and 4 - 6 pm at the Barn.
- Rules:** Works must be ORIGINAL. No copies of paintings. ALL entries to be hung, with the exception of fabric art, must have screw eyes and be securely wired. NO saw tooth hangers or brackets. Fabric art, like quilts, must have a hanging pocket and rod. Sculptures must have a pedestal.
- Removal of Artwork:** **Sunday, June 2nd between 4-6 pm**. No removal prior to that date and time. *If you cannot pick up your artwork by 6 pm, make other arrangements beforehand.*
- Sales:** Price or NFS accepted. HAL requests that artists that sell a painting donate 20 percent of the selling price to HAL. All works must remain in the show until removal date/time.
