

Hamden Art League Exhibition at the Eli Whitney Barn - Special Student Show

Eligibility: Current junior high school students focused on the visual arts from the

following area high schools: Hamden High, Hamden Hall, Sacred Heart Academy, Cheshire High, Amity Region 5 High, North Haven High. Must be supported by the school's or school district's art department chairperson. A maximum of five students per school as determined by the chairperson, only

one entry per student.

Medium: Oils, acrylics, graphics, watercolors, pastels, collage, printmaking (no larger

> than 18" x 24"), wall-hung relief art (not to exceed 3" protrusion, 18" x 24", and 20 lbs.), ceramics (size and weight limitations similar to sculpture) and small

sculptures (18" x 18" base dimension limit, 30 lb. weight limit).

Participation: All entries must be submitted electronically through the Hamden Art League

> website student portal by midnight Monday, May 13th. Submission of an image of artwork is required. Show is non-juried for entries but judged for

awards by **Greg Shea**. See website for further information

Receiving: Wednesday, May 29th between 11 am - 1 pm and 4 - 6 pm at the Barn.

There will be a separate receiving line for students.

Rules: Works must be ORIGINAL. No copies of paintings. ALL entries to be hung,

must have screw eyes and be securely wired. NO saw tooth hangers or

brackets.

Judging: All student submissions will be juried for one of three \$100 prizes. Prizes will

be awarded at the Reception. Student entries including name, title, media and

high school will be included in the exhibition program.

Removal of Artwork:

Sunday, June 2nd between 4-6 pm. No removal prior to that date and time. If

you cannot pick up your artwork by 6 pm, make other arrangements in

advance.

Sales: No sales of student work through the exhibition. All works must remain in the

show until removal date/time.
