



Hamden Art League Exhibition at the Eli Whitney Barn

May 28 – May 31, 2026
940 Whitney Ave, Hamden, CT

- Eligibility:** Paid-up HAL members, two entries allowed not to exceed 48" wide (if exceed 48" wide or is a quilt – only one piece allowed), \$16 each including PayPal fee. Non-members, one entry allowed, \$26 each including PayPal fee. Entry is not complete until payment is made. Payment is made through the Hamden Art League website (<https://www.hamdenartleague.org/join--pay.html>)
- Medium:** Oils, acrylics, graphics, watercolors, pastels, collage, printmaking (hand printed etching, monotype, lithography, etc), mixed media, wall-hung relief art (not to exceed 3" protrusion and 20 lbs.), art quilt/textile art (limited in size to 48" x 48" with hanging pocket and rod unless framed), a limited number of wall hung pieces wider than 48", a limited number of sculptures on pedestal (18" x 18" base dimension limit, 30 lb. weight limit).
- Participation:** Entries must be submitted electronically beginning April 15th and **no later than midnight Friday, May 15th**, through the Hamden Art League website. Submission of an image of artwork is *required*. Show is non-juried for entries but judged for awards by **Janet Warner**. See website for further information (<https://www.hamdenartleague.org/exhibitions.html>).
- Receiving:** **Wednesday, May 27th** between **11 am - 1 pm** and **4 - 6 pm** at the Barn.
- Rules:** Works must be ORIGINAL. No copies of paintings. No AI generated work. Work shown in previous HAL exhibitions will not be accepted. ALL entries to be hung, with the exception of fabric art/quilts, must have screw eyes and be securely wired. NO saw tooth hangers or brackets. Fabric art, like quilts, must have a hanging pocket and rod. Sculptures must have a pedestal.
- Removal of Artwork:** **Sunday, May 31st between 4-6 pm**. No removal prior to that date and time. There is no storage available at the Barn. **IF YOU CANNOT PICK UP YOUR ARTWORK BY 6 PM, YOU MUST MAKE OTHER ARRANGEMENTS BEFOREHAND (BEFORE SUNDAY)**. Artists who do not pick up on time, nor make prior arrangements will be charged a fee to have work returned.
- Sales:** Price or NFS accepted. HAL requests that artists that sell a painting donate 20 percent of the selling price to HAL. All works must remain in the show until removal date/time.
